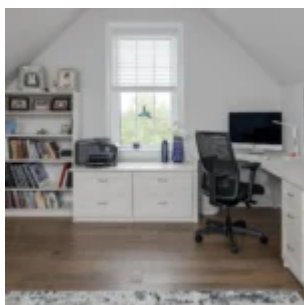


Creating the Perfect Home Office: Your Guide to Design and Layout
